

Directions

From the South:

Follow I-77 to Exit 14 at Hillsville, follow US 221 North (45 mi) to 610 West at second Exxon station;

From the West:

Follow I-81 North, Exit 114 at Christiansburg, VA, follow SR 8 South to Floyd; then left at traffic light on US 221 North (14.2 mi) to 610 West at second Exxon station

From the North:

Follow I-81 South to Exit 143 (I-581) at Roanoke, follow I-581 and US 220 South through Roanoke to the Blue Ridge Parkway, South (14.6 mi) to Adney Gap at Milepost 136, then follow US 221 South to 610 West at Exxon station.

From the East:

Follow I-64 West to junction with I-81 near Staunton, VA. Then follow I-81 South to Roanoke. Follow I-81 South to Exit 143 (I-581) at Roanoke, follow I-581 and US 220 South through Roanoke to the Blue Ridge Parkway, South (14.6 mi) to Adney Gap at Milepost 136, then follow US 221 South to 610 West at Exxon station.

From Blue Ridge Parkway northbound:

Exit at Route 8 North to Floyd, then right at traffic light onto US 221 North (14.2 mi) to 610 West at second Exxon Station.

Then for all of the above:

Follow 610 West 1.3 mi. to 649 North; turn right on 649 and proceed .3 mi. to 792 West for .7 mi and look for the American flag flying on your left at the entrance of Highland Haven.

Watch for sign and WELCOME. (Note: US 221 between Roanoke and 610 West not recommended for RV travel.

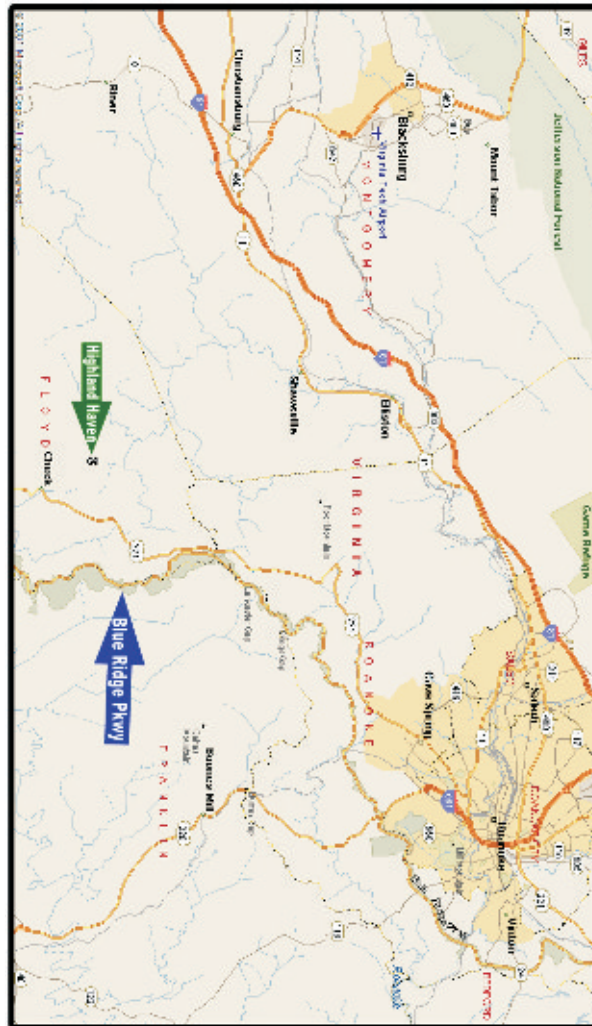

The Park

Nestled in Virginia's Blue Ridge Mountains, at an elevation of 3000 feet, Virginia Highland Haven is a unique park exclusively for Airstreamers. Close to Blacksburg, Christiansburg, and Roanoke the park lies in Southwest Virginia's beautiful Floyd County between I-81 and the famed Blue Ridge Parkway and spreads across seventy-five acres of beautiful hilly terrain with open meadows, hiking trails, fruit trees and a waterfall. These features combined with the parks elevation contribute to an unbelievable hideaway from spring through fall with warm days, cool nights, and ideal sleeping conditions. Marvelous views and spectacular sunsets can be enjoyed without mosquitoes and other pesky insects. Hummingbirds come to visit daily while deer and wild turkeys are easily sighted throughout most of the season.

Highland Haven has forty-six hard-surfaced sites with full hookups and concrete patios. The comfortable clubhouse is the center of activity and houses several high speed DSL hookups, a recently remodeled kitchen, and modern laundry facilities. Park members, as volunteer hosts, greet guests, arrange for a relaxed and comfortable visit as well as plan social and clubhouse activities.

The Area

No other Airstream park along the eastern corridor of the USA offers as much, from simple serene relaxation to the bright lights and eclectic offerings of Roanoke City. Drive the Blue Ridge Parkway with its spectacular vistas and discover the delights of Mabry Mill, and Chateau Morrisette, or hike the trails of The Peaks of Otter. Bluegrass and country music thrive throughout Floyd County. The Friday Night Jamborees at the Floyd Country Store are a unique slice of Americana and a legend not to be missed. Schoolhouse Fabrics, one of the most extensive fabric stores in the US, can be found in Floyd, a scant eighteen miles away, and be prepared to stop and explore the numerous antique shops, general stores, and farmers markets found in the area.
